Free School Meals Vouchers

There seems to have been a bit of confusion regarding FSM vouchers. Normally children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 receive free school meals as part of an initiative called Universal free school meals. 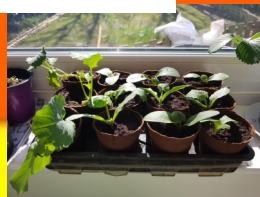

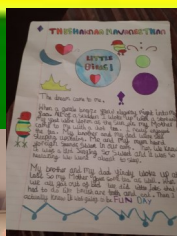

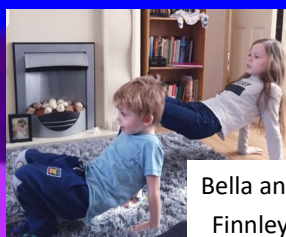
