PAKISTAN FLOODS APPEAL

Floods are devastating Pakistan, leaving millions in need of urgent help to survive. Please donate now.

Devastating floods have hit Pakistan, submerging vast areas of land and leaving 6 million people in need of urgent help.

According to the government of Pakistan, a third of the country - equivalent to an area the size of the UK - is under water. Whole villages have been cut off, with rescuers struggling to reach them. At least 1,300 people have been killed and 12,703 injured. Huge areas of agricultural land have been affected, with crops swept away and three quarters of a million livestock killed, which will mean many people going hungry in the longer term.

houses have been destroyed or badly damaged

as much rainfall as the 39 year average in the most hit areas

in 40 locations across the country have been damaged

acres of crops have been affected, and 750,000 livestock lost
