Attendance and Punctuality

Children must be in school every day unless they are ill. Attendance and punctuality are monitored by the local authority and can result in legal action being taken.

Jewellery and Accessories

Hair accessories should be kept to a minimum

Clubs

If your child has chosen to take part in a club and they are allocated a place, then they must attend each week. If this is not the case they will lose their place.

Extended Leave

Extended Leave will not be authorised and the Local Authority will fine families that break this rule. The fine is £60 per parent per child.

Pick ups

Children must be picked up on time from school and from clubs. Failure to do this will result in charges as per our charging policy.

All homework should be completed by the date given. Logins can be requested from your child's class teacher if you need a repeat set.
