This week all classes have been celebrating the work of different authors by creating different pieces of writing and art work based on one particular book.

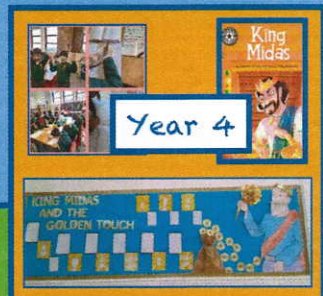
This year the theme has been royalty. Each book chosen has a link to a King, Queen, Prince or Princess as this year we will be celebrating the Coronation of King Charles III.

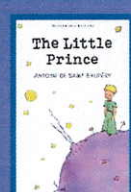

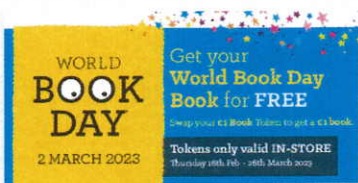
