#### Children are expected to attend Nursery every day.


We have reviewed our attendance policy in the light of poor Nursery attendance.



#### **Express Afternoon**


Thank you to everyone who attended Express afternoon. Once again it was a huge success!! We also hope you enjoyed our class art gallery in the hall.


